SASA Scholarship Application Instructions

1. Neatly fill in the information requested on this form – incomplete forms will not be considered.
2. If you have completed the SAA video application process, no tape is needed. If you have not, or have not yet been accepted, please include a copy of your tape or DVD using the same criteria as SAA. Accompaniment is suggested, but optional. **This tape must be in VHS (full size) or DVD format to be accepted.** Make sure your name is on the tape or DVD container.
3. Provide two letters of recommendation, from at least one person who knows your playing skills.
4. Please write a paragraph or two about why you would like this scholarship and what your goals are for Suzuki teaching.
5. Attach a copy of your previous year's federal income tax form and please include a statement describing any extenuating circumstances, financial or otherwise, that should be taken into consideration.
6. Send the tape/DVD (if applicable), application and related materials in a padded envelope to the address above.
7. All scholarship recipients are required to do three hours of volunteer time for the institute. You will be contacted about job opportunities if you are awarded a scholarship.
